

Clarification regarding Declaration of Conformity statements

This short document clarifies why Declaration of Conformity (DoC) statements are unavailable for some Axis products. The reason is that some types of products are out of scope of the CE-marking EU directives. They cannot bear the CE mark and, therefore, no DoC applies.

DoC is a legal document issued by the manufacturer of a product placed on the EU market. The DoC provides a statement that attests that the CE-marked product is in accordance with the relevant product legislation. The DoC must also list the applicable EU directives as well as the harmonized standards that were used in order to assure the compliance.

Some Axis products are out of scope of all CE-marking EU directives. This is the case for several types of accessories that have a purely mechanical functionality, for example

- Mechanical mounts (without any electrical functionality)
- Camera housings (without any electrical functionality)
- Optical equipment with manual/mechanical iris and zoom functionality

Such products cannot bear the CE mark, and therefore no DoC can be issued.
